

NIAGARA COMPLIANCE AUDIT COMMITTEE

APPLICATION FOR COMPLIANCE AUDIT

Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (Section 88.33 and 88.34)

An elector who is entitled to vote in an election and believes on reasonable grounds that a candidate or registered third party has contravened any of the provisions of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* relating to campaign finances may apply for a compliance audit of the candidate or registered third party advertiser's campaign finances, even if the candidate or registered third party advertiser has not filed a financial statement.

An application for a compliance audit must be received as follows:

- For Regional Chair and Regional Councillor candidates – by the Regional Clerk
- For Mayor, Councillors/Aldermen, Trustee Candidates and Registered Third Party Advertisers – by the Clerk of the applicable area municipality

Within 90 days after the latest of the following dates:

- the filing date, which is the last Friday in March following the election (by 2:00 p.m. Friday, March 29, 2019);
- the date the candidate or registered third party advertiser filed a financial statement, if the statement was filed within 30 days after the filing date, which is the last Friday in March following the election;
- the candidate's or registered third party advertiser's supplementary filing date, if any, which is the last Friday in September in the year following the election (by 2:00 p.m. Friday September 27, 2019);
- the date on which the candidate's or registered third party advertiser's extension approved by the court, if any, expires.
